

Accessing our Information

We want to make sure that you can read and understand the information that we show on our website. There are some simple steps you can follow to amend the settings on your devices, which will help you to access information across the Internet. Please review these details below:


Reading Aloud / Screen Reading

Computers running Windows 10 all have built in screen readers that can read information out to the user. You will need to use the Microsoft Edge Internet browser for this to work.

For Phones, IOS and Android devices can screen read via the accessibility settings. This can be turned on in the main settings of your device.

Translation to other languages

The website can be translated by using the built in translator available on google chrome. To access this you will need to search 'google translate add on' and select Google translate. From this page you can add this extension to the chrome browser.

Going forward, you will then be able to select the  icon to translate web pages into your selected language.

Larger Text

You can enlarge your view by zooming in on pages using the built in windows magnifier, or by holding 'Ctrl' and scrolling up. For Mac OS, you can zoom in by allowing magnification in the settings menu.

Zooming in on our website pages will change the page view from desktop to mobile view, keeping its clarity.
